

Basic facts about College Bank & Lower Falinge Neighbourhood - census 2011

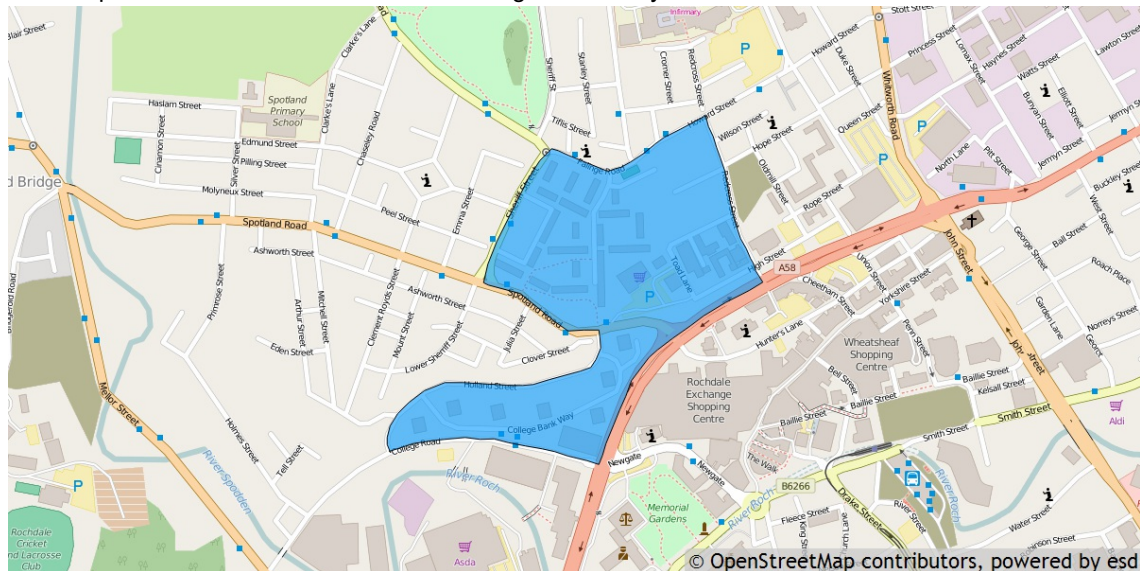
This report provides a summary of the latest available information on the demographic and socio-economic make-up of the College Bank & Lower Falinge Neighbourhood within England Country. It looks at the population structure and provides information on the economic, housing and educational achievement of the Neighbourhood.

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College Bank & Lower Falinge is one of the 5 Neighbourhoods of England. It has an area of 6 hectares which represents 0.00% of the total area of England Country.



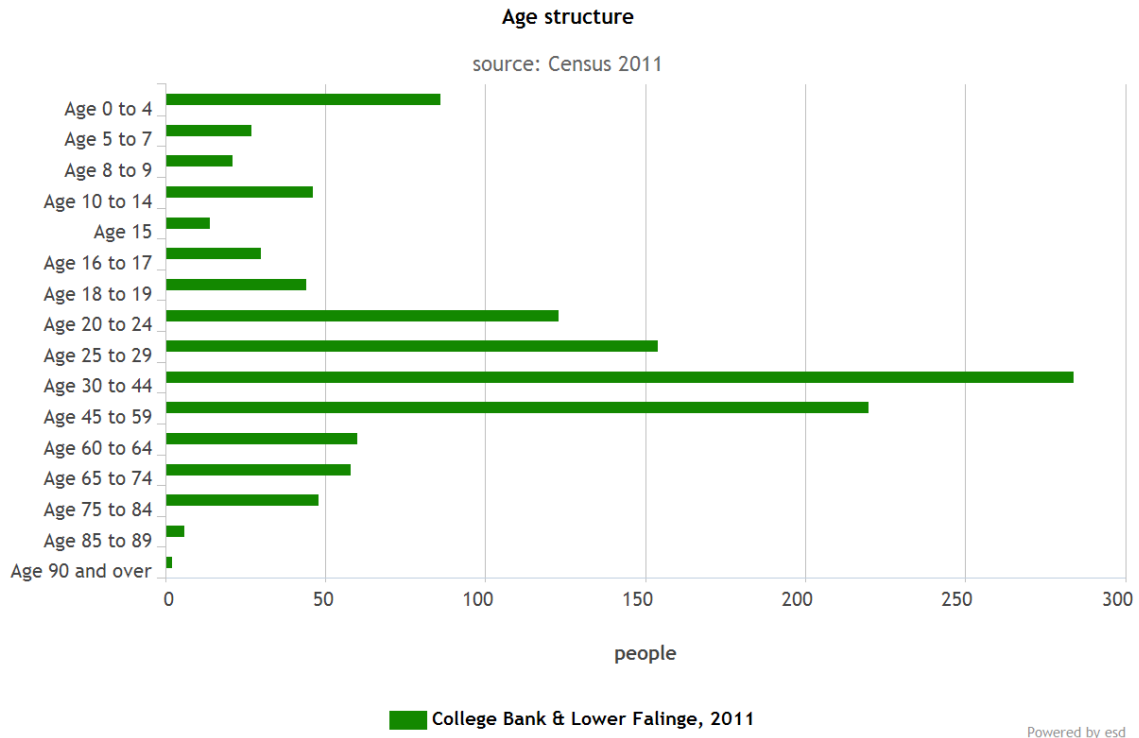
Residents

College Bank & Lower Falinge has a resident population of 1,223 which represents 0.00% of the total England Country resident population of 53,012,456.

College Bank & Lower Falinge's resident population is 41.1% female and 58.9% male.

Age

The mean age of the College Bank & Lower Falinge Neighbourhood population is 35 years compared to a mean age of 39 years for residents in the whole of England . The predominant age band in College Bank & Lower Falinge is Age 30 to 44 which represents 23.22% of the total Neighbourhood population.

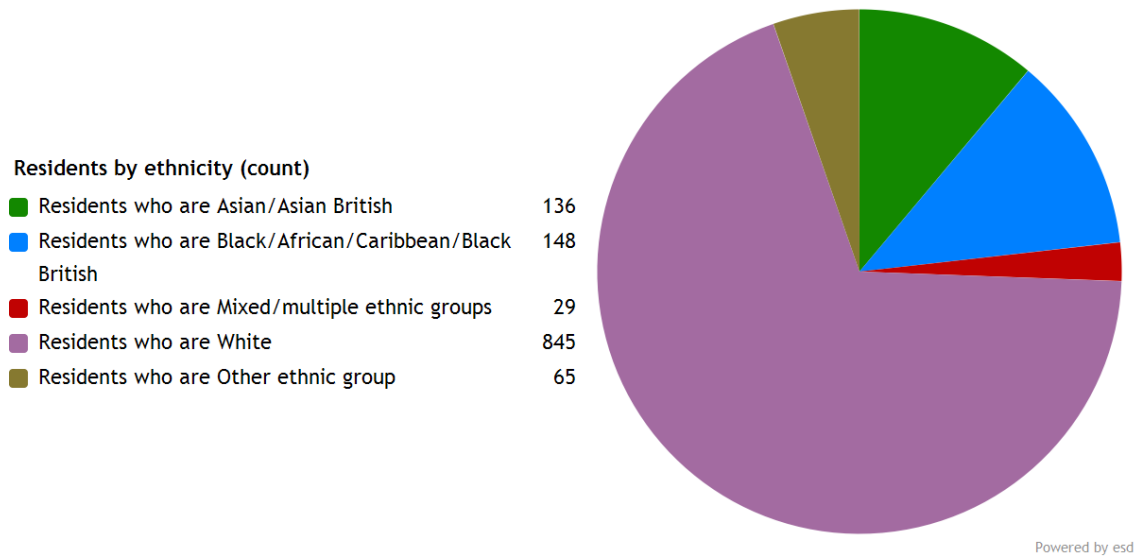


Ethnicity

The largest ethnic group in College Bank & Lower Falinge is 'Number of usual residents who are White' with 69.1% of the Neighbourhood's population. That compares with a figure of 85.4% for England Country as a whole and 85.4% for United Kingdom .

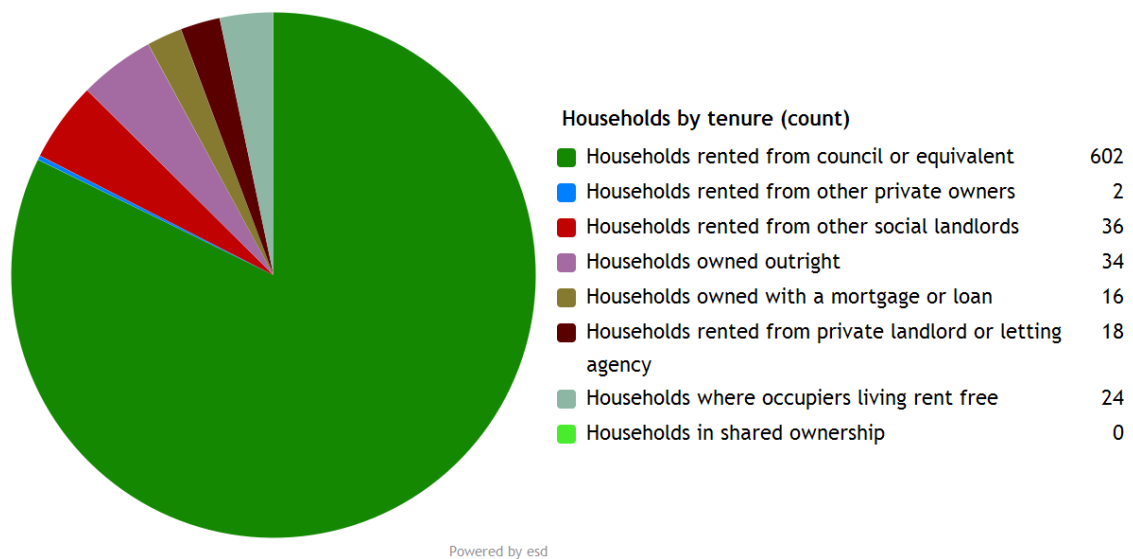
The second largest ethnic group is 'Number of usual residents who are Asian/Asian British' with 12.1% of the Neighbourhood's population. That compares with 3.5% for the Country as a whole and no value for United Kingdom.

The ethnic split of College Bank & Lower Falinge's residents is shown below.



Households

College Bank & Lower Falinge Neighbourhood has 732 households, which represent 0.00% of England's 22,063,368 households. The household split by tenure is shown below.



The largest number of households lives in 'Number of all households - Social rented: Rented from council (Local Authority)' accommodation with 82.2% of College Bank & Lower Falinge households. That compares with 10.1% for England Country as a whole and no value for United Kingdom.

The second largest number of households lives in 'Percentage of all households - Social rented: Other' accommodation with 4.9% of the Neighbourhood's households. That compares with 5.7% for the Country as a whole and no value for United Kingdom.

College Bank & Lower Falinge has 60 households with dependent children aged 0 to 4. That represents 8.20% of the Neighbourhood's households.

119 households in the Neighbourhood have dependent children of all ages. That represents 16.26% of

the Neighbourhood's households.

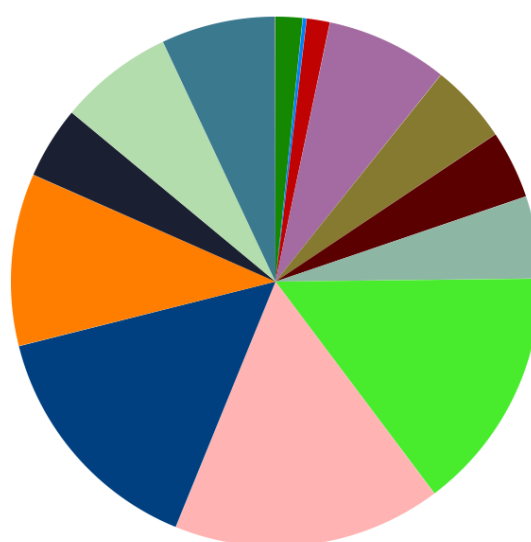
Employment

The following chart provides a breakdown of College Bank & Lower Falinge Neighbourhood by socio-economic classification for all residents aged 16 – 74.

The National Statistics Socio-economic Classification (NS-SEC) provides an indication of socio-economic position based on occupation. It is an Office for National Statistics standard classification. To assign a person aged 16 to 74 to an NS-SEC category their occupation title is combined with information about their employment status, whether they are employed or self-employed, and whether or not they supervise other employees. Full-time students are recorded in the 'full-time students' category regardless of whether they are economically active or not.

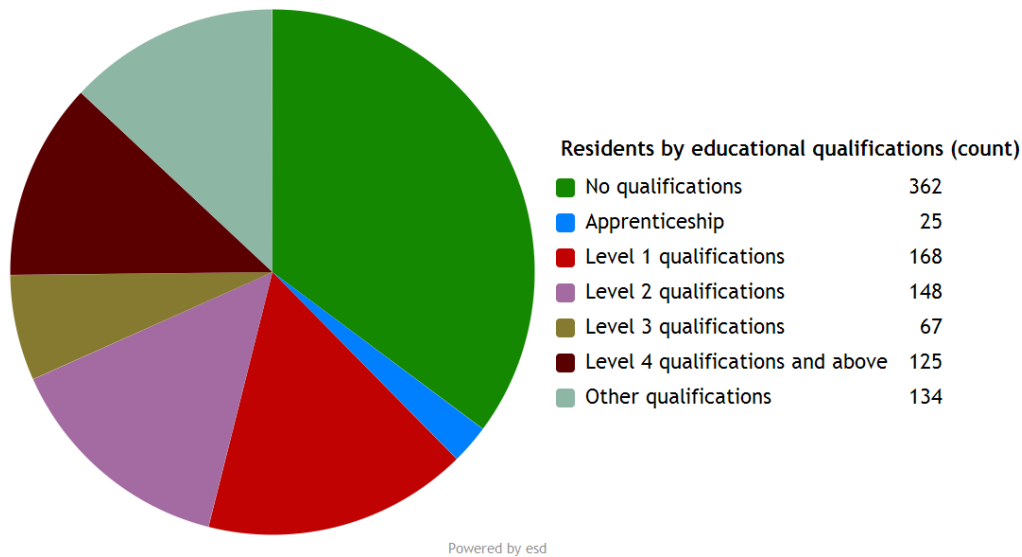

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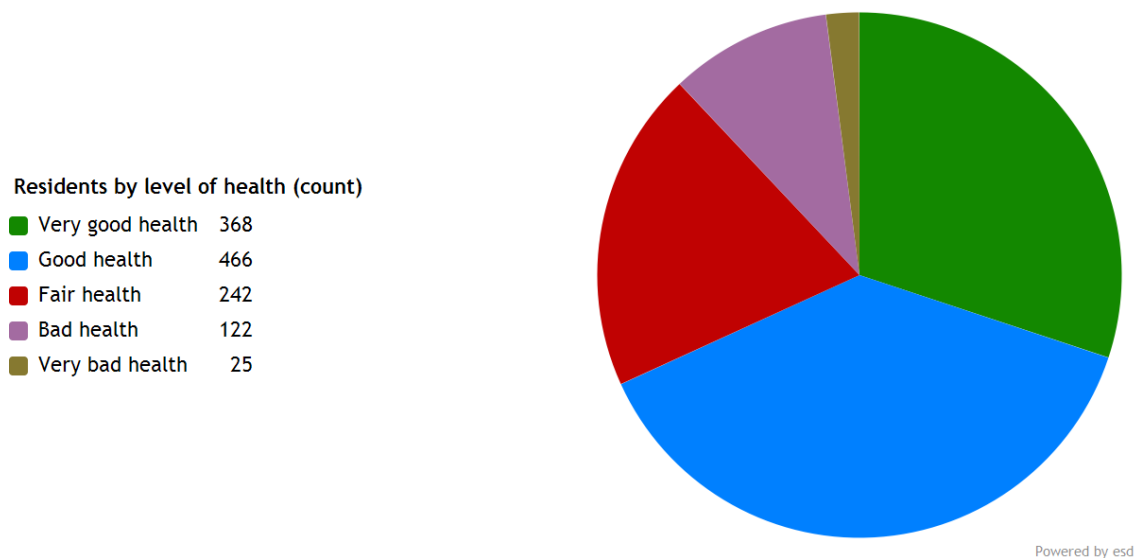
The largest group is National Statistics Socio-Economic Classification - 7. Routine occupations representing 17.09% of the Neighbourhood's population.

Education



10.22% of College Bank & Lower Falinge's residents have achieved level 4 qualifications and above compared to 27.40% in England as a whole and 29.60% of College Bank & Lower Falinge's residents have no qualifications compared to 22.50% in England .

Health



College Bank & Lower Falinge has 122 (10.0%) residents that report being in bad health and 25 (2.0%) residents that report being in very bad health.

Its ranking for the number of residents in very bad health is 5 (out of 5 Neighbourhoods) within England.
