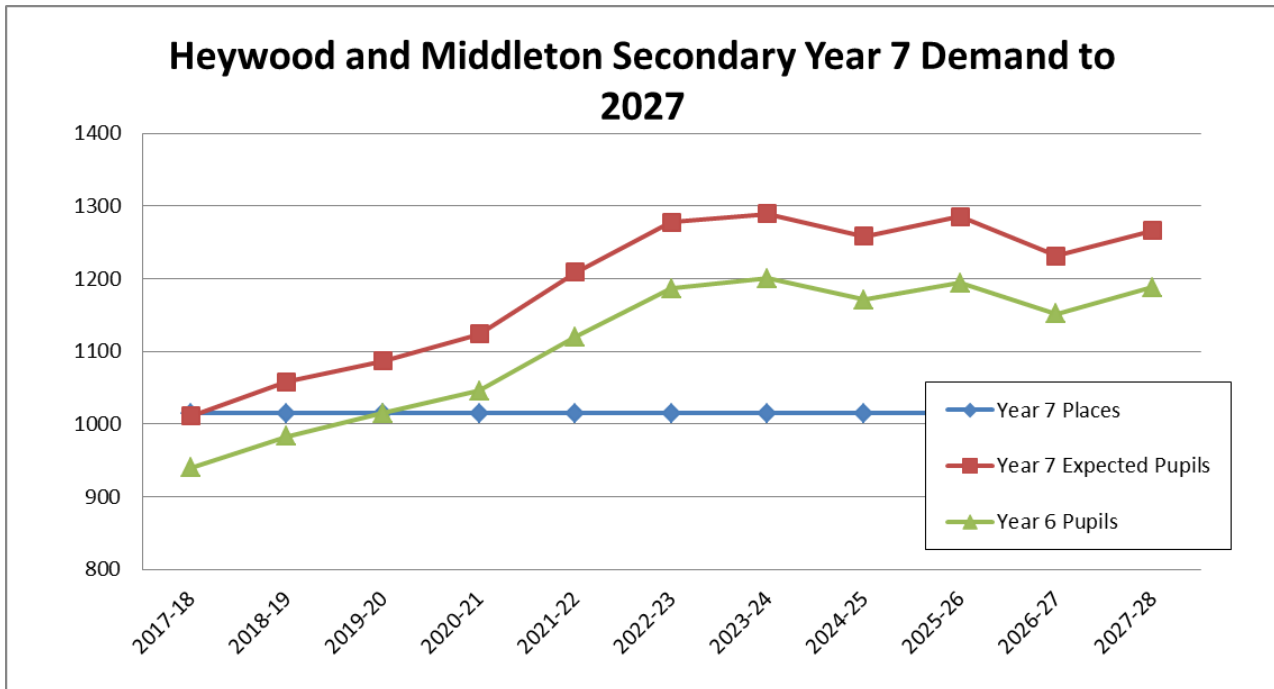


# APPENDIX 6 HEYWOOD and MIDDLETON TOWNSHIPS Year 7 Secondary School Places 2017 - 2027



6% more children attend Secondaries than Primaries in the Heywood and Middleton region with more pupils commuting into the area. Currently forecasts suggest a deficit of places for next September (2018) with this demand rising until 2023/24. New A Free School will be needed by 2020.
