Landscaping of the communal area will involve the removal of extensive overgrowth and planting of multiple mature fruit trees (wild and culinary varieties) to create an orchard for tenants and service users to harvest fresh fruit for eating and a wildlife habitat to encourage the tenants to enjoy time outdoors observing nature to improve their mental and physical wellbeing. Activities of cultivating, maintenance and harvesting of the fruit trees will teach the tenants and service users practical horticultural skills and encourage healthy eating.
