A number of dead and dying trees will be removed to open up the entrance to the area. The wildflower meadow will provide a colourful attractive floral display and a nectar rich environment for bees, butterflies and other pollinating insects. The bollards provide a secure and cost-effective way to restrict vehicle access with reinforced anti-ram specifications and they are fully retractable (designed to lock into position when required and slide below ground when not needed). W/42/19	Tweedale Street bollards	Supply and installation of 29 Manchester type bollards on the southerly footway of Tweedale Street between Dorset Street and Mere Street to prevent vehicles from parking partially on the footway to improve pedestrian safety and stop damage to the footway. Vehicles parked on footways can force pedestrians into the road which is particularly dangerous for blind and partially sighted people, parents with pushchairs and young children, wheelchair users and others who use mobility aids. Footway surfaces are not designed to carry the weight of vehicles and damaged paving is a potential tripping hazard, and the added maintenance cost of repairing the footway adds an unnecessary financial burden to the Council.
