Course participants will have the opportunity to obtain an in-depth understanding of people's mental health and factors that affect wellbeing, practical skills to spot the triggers and signs of mental health issues, confidence to reassure and support people in distress, and enhanced interpersonal skills such as non-judgemental listening. Also the course will provide participants with the knowledge to help people recover their health by guiding them to further support and engaging with parents, carers and external agencies where appropriate, ability to support a people with a long term mental health issue or disability to thrive and tools to look after their own mental wellbeing.
