<b>Project Description</b>	Investigation into the speeds of vehicles travelling along Bury Old Road, Heywood (local distributor road extending between Bury new Road and Heap Brow) to determine whether or not additional speed reduction measures should be considered. Four speed surveys will be undertaken to account for the change in character along the route and a report with options produced after a review of the results. (Project brief at Appendix 4A)

<b>Project Description</b>	Rochdale Hornets Sporting Foundation is the charitable arm of Rochdale Hornets Rugby Club and they propose to deliver the Heywood TRY programme that will provide young people with the opportunity to participate in a series of high quality rugby league coaching sessions and taster sessions in Heywood Township primary and secondary schools. Using the inspiration of the Rugby League World Cup (RLWC2021) that will be taking place in 2021 across the country between 23 October and 27 November 2021 and in the same year Rochdale Hornets Rugby League Club will be 150 years, Rochdale Hornets Sporting Foundation want to 'get more young people involved and playing rugby league more often', raise the profile of the sport in the borough and encourage local schools to sign up to the resources and promote the RLWC2021 Education Resources as part of their school's work through the TRY programme. It is proposed to establish a brand new Junior Hornet 150 Club that will see 150 young people from across the four Townships attend every Hornets home fixture and become lifelong supporters of rugby league and Rochdale Hornets and players of the future. The TRY programme will aim to support young people into rugby league and an active lifestyle and increase the awareness and profile of the RLWC2021 in 2020 to build the momentum for the event in the borough. Members of the public including family and carers are asked to pay a modest ticket price with proceeds going towards the cost of the production. The show encourages vulnerable adults and young people to become more active in their local community, manage their physical and emotional health and it reduces social isolation. <b>Project Description</b>	Sandon House Community Centre have established a meals delivery service on Thursday evenings and Monday lunchtimes to support the local community and it is proposed to introduce a pre-booked luncheon club for 20 once a week with entertainment and activities that adhere to social distancing guidance. A commercial dishwasher would improve the operation by providing additional space in the kitchen to enable enhanced social distancing for volunteers/staff safety, increase efficiency of labour and the confidence of serving the community on sanitised kitchenware.
