The maintenance of the Christmas tree will be the responsibility of Rochdale Boroughwide Housing. Groundwork Oldham Rochdale (Rochdale Boroughwide Housing's Green Team Partnership) will plant the Christmas tree with works involving their apprentices who are studying for NVQ2 in landscaping.
