M/06/20	Duke Street Alley Clearance	Clearance and removal of vegetation and detritus from the alleyway at the rear of 92-122 Duke Street and 5-69 Duke Street, Rochdale to improve the environment for the local community. Access for the residents at the rear of their properties is restricted by the excessive vegetation and it is encouraging fly tipping. Environmental Management propose to continue engagement with the residents about the maintenance of the alley once it is cleared.	Central Rochdale	£750	28 July 2020	Awarded £750 from Members Fund
M/25/19	Cutgate Bungalows flower bed	Restoration of a flower bed at the front of bungalows in Cutgate on a communal green space that is currently unkempt. Rochdale Boroughwide Housing will facilitate the removal of weeds, the installation of a weed control membrane and planting with seasonal bulbs and shrubs to create attractive floral displays throughout the year. Plants selected will be low maintenance to enable the elderly residents to participate and enjoy light gardening activities with the support of Rochdale Boroughwide Housing staff. The Covid-19 pandemic has necessitated a change in how activities can be delivered and a laptop for the co-ordinator would enhance communications with/activities for the community groups with technology to be used to deliver zoom chats, create online videos (crafts, storytelling, songs, dance and cooking) and to produce newsletters to maintain contact with the local community who are unable or unwilling to use computers. The group proposes to resume once Covid restrictions permit and in preparation they are seeking to replace donated second hand toys with new toys that can be easily cleaned/sanitised. M/08/20	Uniforms for all	Spotland Methodist Church's community volunteers propose to work in partnership with Cutgate Co-op store to deliver a school uniform recycling initiative to help local families who are experiencing financial difficulties obtain pre-loved free school uniforms for their children and an opportunity to divert discarded clothing from ending up at a landfill site. Staff at Cutgate Co-op store will collect donations of uniforms from the public and volunteers from Spotland Methodist Church will sort, arrange the laundering of the clothing, store and distribute to children identified by local schools' pastoral support teams as in need of uniforms in the Spotland & Falinge Ward. The provision of clothes rails, hangers, shoe rack, storage boxes and a clothes steamer will enable the volunteers to effectively process the school uniforms received after the items have been cleaned at a local laundrette.
