W/02/20	Kingsway Bulky Waste Amnesty Tipping Cost	Kingsway Bulky Waste Amnesty assisted local residents from the Kingsway Ward with the removal of bulky waste items from their properties. Items suitable for refurbishment or reuse were stored and offered back through furniture reuse charities or directly to members of the public at little or no costs. Bulky items were diverted from landfill whenever possible and any residue from this process handpicked for recyclable items and energy production. Tipping costs are approximately £250 per tonne and the total weight of the bulky items was not known until taken for disposal. Kingsway Bulky Waste Amnesty was successfully delivered and the amount of bulky items disposed of resulted in a shortfall to cover the tipping cost incurred.
