Project Description	Rochdale Cycling Without Age propose to acquire a specially adapted bicycle (Trishaw) to enable older people, initially from the Pennines Township area, to participate in bike rides in parks and the countryside. The project aims to address loneliness, social isolation and the wellbeing of older people with limited mobility in the community as the Trishaw rides will give them the opportunity to meet people and enjoy nature in local green spaces. Younger people with physical or learning disabilities will also be able to access the rides. The free Trishaw rides will be provided by volunteer 'pilots' who will be trained and DBS checked. The number and availability of volunteer 'pilots' will determine the number of bike rides offered with the intention of the rides being for 1 to 1.5 hours duration with the initial route around the Hollingworth Lake area. Taster sessions and events to attract both passengers and 'pilots' will be held once lockdown and social distancing measures have been lifted. (Application form at Appendix 5A)

Project Description	Littleborough Arts Festival CIO aims to revive and extend the festival both in terms of its scope (arts) and its reach (inclusivity and engagement) with their overall plan in the next couple of years to boost arts activity, participation, capacity and confidence in and around Littleborough and the wider Pennines Township, both in response to the covid pandemic and recovery and in preparation for the 2022 Littleborough Arts Festival. Online arts workshops across a variety of arts media and through local artists and facilitators have been delivered during early 2021 as the Littleborough Arts Festival had to be cancelled due to the Covid pandemic. Littleborough Arts Festival CIO propose to double their current capacity of workshops through the provision of blended learning (online and safe face to face) to enable 60 local people to participate in art.
