The Willows Dementia Hub's three garden areas facilitate gardening clubs that encourage residents and the local community to grow their own herbs, vegetables and flowers. A priority is to build on their existing good work in their community gardens and on the advice of the Rochdale In Bloom members. It is proposed to increase the sustainability of the gardens by introducing large water butts in each garden and a compost bin and wormery to recycle kitchen waste from the community café. Also the provision of a variety of bedding plants, sensory shrubs, compost/soil and display containers will enhance the gardens. The Willows Community Garden Project is beneficial to all participants' health and wellbeing and it encourages an understanding and respect for people living with dementia. Damage to the pitch causes safety concerns for the children training/playing football and results in addition expense for the football club to undertake the repairs. The fence installation around the pitch proposed is a 2.4m high anti climb mesh fence incorporating a double gate for maintenance access and a maximum of four individual gates for pedestrian access. The Football Foundation has approved in principle 75% of the cost for the fence subject to agreement from Rochdale Borough Council to erect the fence and agreement on the specification.
