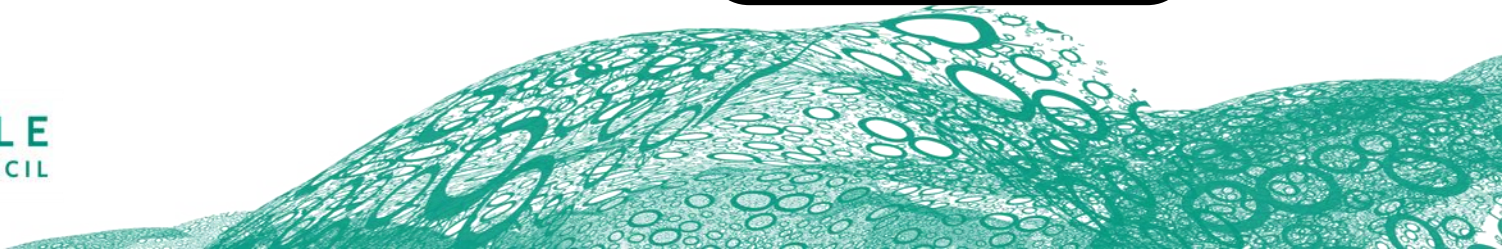

What would make it better?

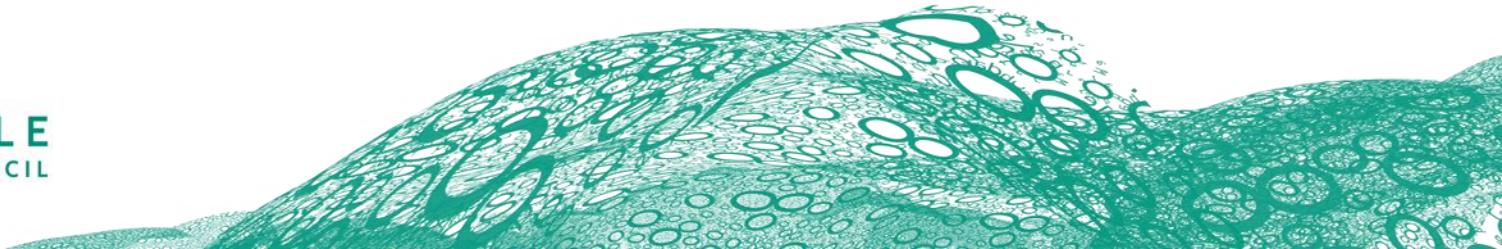
What are some of the key issues bothering you and concerns?
